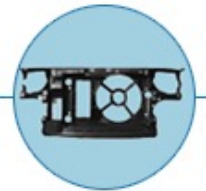
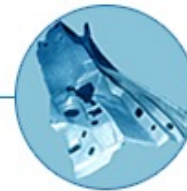

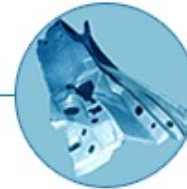


# Introduction to the company

- Ship to over 30 customers from our US Location

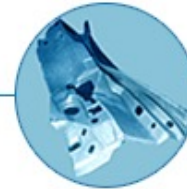


# US IT Landscape
